

Installation Guide for Stepping Posts

All stepping posts need to be install with a fixing post.

Prior to installation:-

We recommend that the depth of the bore hole in the step post is measured and marked on the fixing post to ensure accurate installation. The figures are for guidance only.

200mm step post 100mm above ground level
300mm step post 200mm above ground level
400mm step post 300mm above ground level
500mm step post 400mm above ground level
600mm step post 500mm above ground level

The hole for the post should be dug to the right level and the galvanised fixing post should be concreted into the ground ensuring that it protrudes at least 250mm above the ground onto which the product is to be sited. The amount of the fixing post left protruding above ground level will depend on the size of the step post to be installed.

Once the concrete has set then two vertical beads of adhesive should be applied to the outer surface of the fixing post and the inner core of the product. The product should then be placed over the tube and pressed to ground level using a twisting action motion to spread the adhesive around the post.

1 x 310ml tube of adhesive is recommended for 2 to 3 items.

Once the adhesive has set a lasting bond between the fixing post and the product is then achieved giving a permanent fix. This should left for at least 24hours to set off before any one uses the play item.
